

Wireless Access for Guests

The guest network (WVU.Guest) offers short-term access for non-WVU users for up to 5 days of wireless connectivity.

To Self-Register

1. Select WVU Guest from your device's Wifi list.
- If you are unable to find the network on your device, you may also register at:

3. Complete the fields.
4. Click Register.

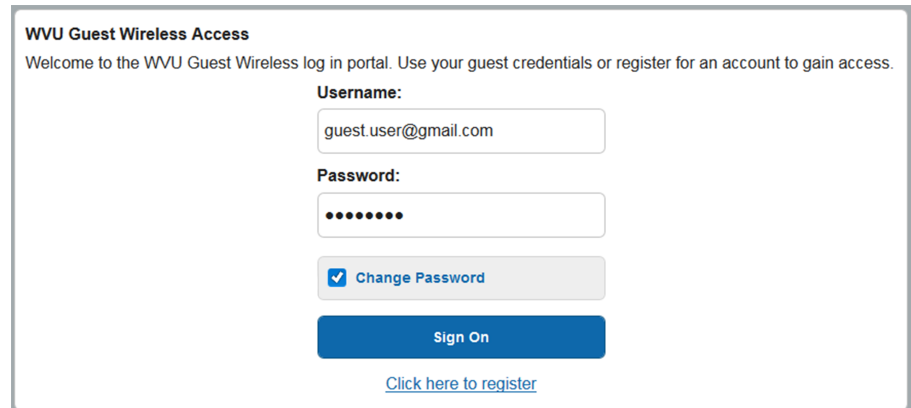

To Connect to the Guest Network

1. Enter your **Username**, (usually your email address,) and paste the **Password from**

- If your login doesn't work or you forgot to copy your password. Check your email that you used to register for your username.
